Chill grade - ideal for sandwich/chilled food labelling.

Designed for laminates in a wide range of applications. Very good heat resistance which enables trouble free performance in different hot fusing print processes. Good adhesion to cardboard and low energy (e.g. plastic bags) surfaces.

Good 'all round' permanent adhesive.

Approved for indirect food contact and direct contact on dry and moist non-fatty foods.

Backing

White high density kraft paper with excellent lay flat properties.

Printing Information

Litho:

Treat as a coated paper.

Die cut labels - use extra low tack inks (formulated - not reduced) and hard blanket.

Laser:

As the paper is a coated grade be aware of potential 'bubbles' in the top surface on some very hot fusing laser printers.

May be problems with toner transfer/surface static issues on some laser printing technologies e.g. OKI printers.

Please request samples for testing.

Set paper type as 'extra heavy weight' 170 - 180gsm.
